1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Name: Amlexanox Oral Paste, 5% (Aphthasol®).

Description: Granular, beige/tan-colored paste in plastic tube.

Category: Prescription drug for treatment of aphthous ulcers (canker sores).

3. HEALTH HAZARD DATA

Primary Routes of Exposure: Skin contact, eye contact, ingestion.

Effects of Overexposure:

Skin: Prolonged and repeated contact may cause sensitization

Eves: May cause mild irritation

Ingestion: Gastrointestinal upset (diarrhea, vomiting) may result from overdose

First Aid Procedure:
